Parent Consultations



Before September...

When your child starts Reception there are a number of skills that they should ideally have mastered:

Self-care:

- Go to the toilet by self
- Be able to wash own hands
- Put on own shoes and socks
- Put on coat and do zip
- Eat using knife and fork

Speaking & Literacy:

- Show an interest in books
- Recognise and begin to write own name
- Talk about themselves, needs & feelings
- Ask and answer simple questions

Numeracy:

- Count to 10
- Recognise numbers to 10
- Write some numbers to 10
- Name simple shapes

Listening and understanding:

- Be able to tidy up
- Follow instructions
- Share and take turns
- Talk to other children

Links with other professionals

Whilst the school doesn't provide daily after school childcare, there is a privately run afterschool club on the premises, please see your pack for further details.

What next...

- You should have received your admissions pack. Please read it carefully!
- **Complete the Admissions Form** and return it to the school office asap in September with 2 proofs of your address no older than 2 months and your child's passport and birth certificate. **Your child will not be able to start school if it hasn't been completed.**

Dates and Times

In your pack you will have received a letter with further dates and times such as:

1) Open evening

- Monday 10th July - RP & RF classes at 3.30pm - 4.30pm
- Wednesday 12th July - RS and RW classes at 3.30pm - 4.30pm
- Please bring your child to the session based on the class allocated to them.

2) Parent Interview date

- Please bring your child's red health record if you have one.
- Please bring your child with you to the meeting so that they can meet the teacher and see the environment before they start.

What does it involve?

What does it involve?

Staff will also ask you questions to help them better understand your child's needs and interests.

Start Dates

- Please look at your timetable for your child's start date and time.
- There is a staggered start in order to support your child settling in.
- All children will be staying for lunch from the start.

- We will keep you informed at all times.
- These time scales are variable to meet the individual needs of the child.
