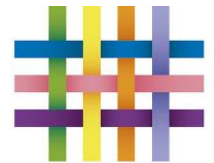

HOW YOU CAN HELP US

- **Answering questions about outings you have been on**
- **Provide instructions for them to follow e.g. please put your toys in the box and choose a reading book**

- **Complete the Admissions Form and return it to the school office with proof of your address and your child's passport or birth certificate. Your child will not be able to start school without a completed form.**
- **Put dates and times in your diary: the open day date, your child's home visit date and start date.**
- **Please register with the Children Centre, where you can attend a variety of stimulating activities for your child over the long summer holiday, as well as a selection of services that are available for you and your family.**

HOME VISITS

What does it involve?

2 members of staff will visit you at home.

This is an opportunity for you and your child to meet the staff in a familiar environment.

Staff will ask you questions to help them better understand your child's needs and interests.

Please check your pack for your home visit date.

If the date or time is not suitable please speak to me at the end.



START DATES

- There is staggered start in order to support your child settling in.
- We expect parents to stay with the children for at least the first day if unsettled.
- You may even need to be in school with your child for a few days in order to settle them fully.
