Before September...

When you child starts Reception there are a number of skills that they should ideally have mastered:

Self-care:

- · Go to the toilet by self
- Be able to wash own hands
- Dress and undress by self
- Button and unbutton clothes
- Put on own shoes and socks
- Put on coat and do zip
- Eat using knife and fork

Speaking & Literacy:

- Show an interest in books
- Recognise and write own name
- Talk about myself, needs & feelings
- Ask and answer simple questions

Numeracy:

- Count to 20
- Recognise numbers to 20
- Write numbers to 20
- Name simple shapes

Listening and understanding:

- Be able to tidy up
- Follow instructions
- Share and take turns
- Talk to other children

- On site we have the Children's Centre who offer a variety of services and activities. Please speak to a member of staff and make sure you complete a registration form.
