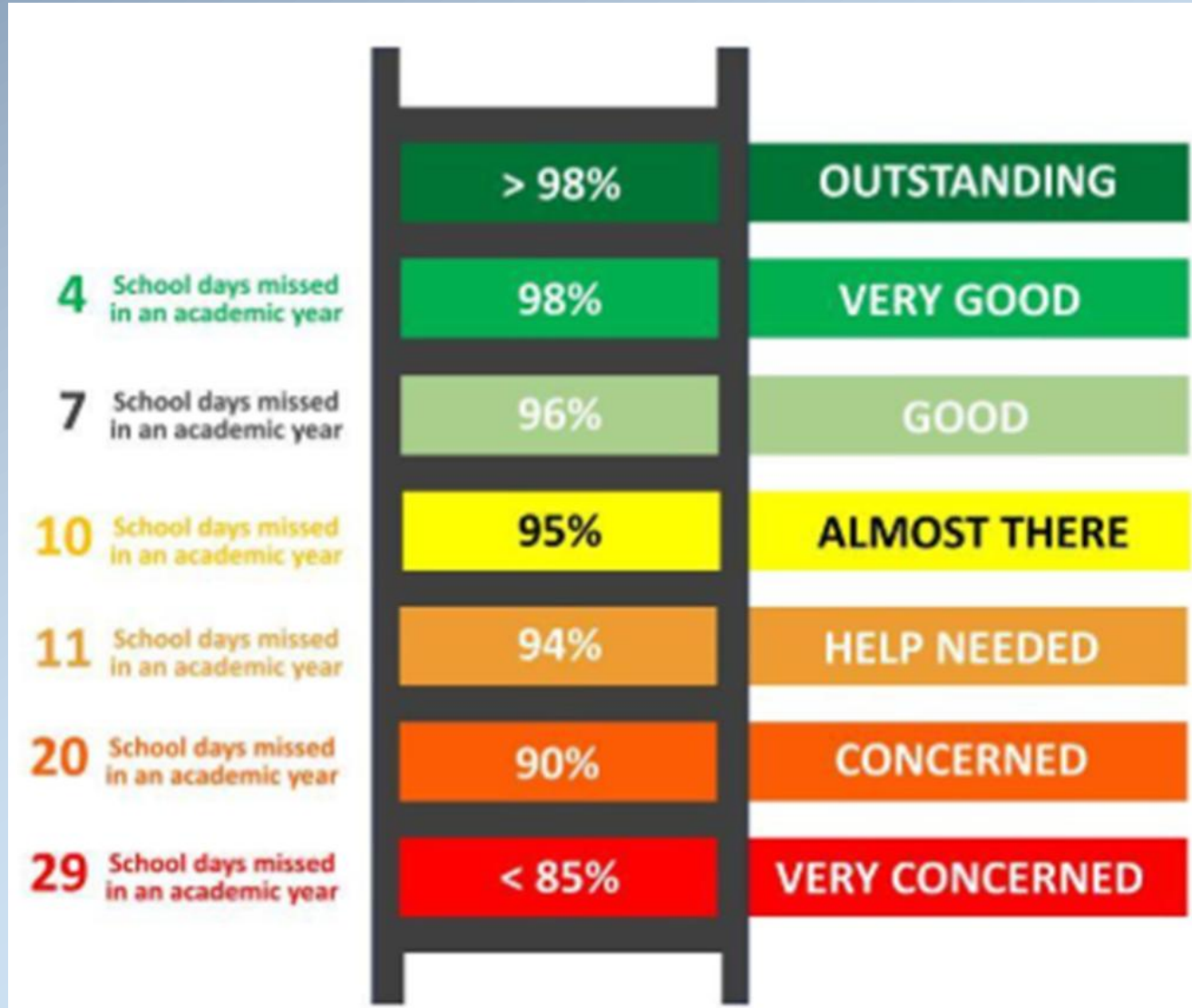

Attendance and Punctuality



- It is vital that your child comes to school **every day** and on time
- We **do not authorise** any term-time holidays. Unauthorised holidays **may result in a fine** by the Educational Welfare Officer
- Soft start begins at **8:35**
- Registers close at **8.50**
(Teaching starts promptly and your child will be marked late if they arrive after this time.)
- Please ensure you are collecting your children on time from the classroom at **3:20pm**.

School Lunch and Snacks

- **All children in Year 2** are entitled to a free school meal. You do not need to pay!
- Your child does not have to have a school dinner every day. Check the school website to see the menus and you can choose which meals your child would like to eat.
- Year 2 children do not need to bring in a snack as this is provided for all children in the year group. However, should you wish to send a snack in with your child, please ensure it is **healthy and nut-free** eg. Fruit, vegetable (the same rule applies for packed lunches).
- If you are in receipt of any benefits, please apply for Free School Meals. You can enquire about this at the main Reception.

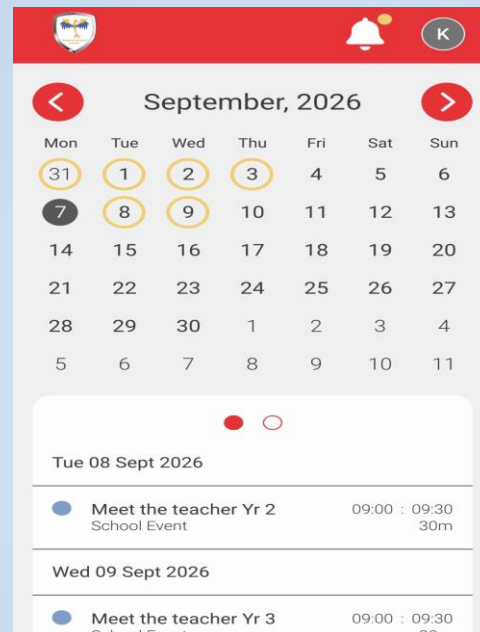
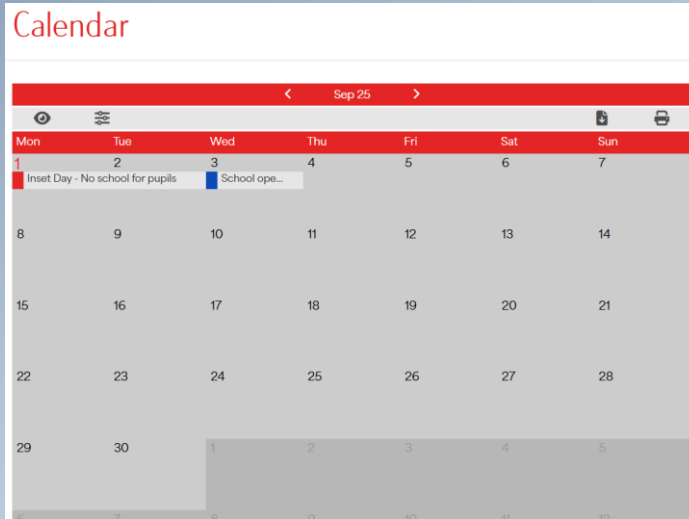
Reading

- Children are expected to read for at least **10-15 minutes** every day.
- To begin, books will be a **phonetically decodable book** which will focus on the sound your child has been learning in the week. Children will then move onto colour-banded books once they are phonetically secure.
- Reading books will be changed **once a week in Autumn Term** then twice a week from Spring Term onwards.
- Reading records **must** be signed by an adult and brought in **daily**.
- New books **will not be given** if the Reading record is not in school.
- Lost/damaged books will be charged **£5 per book**.

After School Clubs

- A list of After School clubs will be available in the next 2 weeks. Children will only be able to **attend one session per week**.
- The booking will go live on **Parent Pay at 5pm on the release day**. If a space is available, children will be given their 1st choice club then removed from any additional preferences.
- **Waiting lists** will be created if a club is over-subscribed. Additional spaces may be offered if available. You will be contacted from the school office, if a place becomes available.
- **Invited (booster) clubs** – You will receive a letter from a class teacher prior to clubs becoming available. This is a paid but reduced-price club (*£15 instead of £17*) and will run for 8 weeks. Booster Club invites will go to children based on teacher assessments to address specific gaps in learning.

Trips



- Our [parent calendar](#) of key dates is updated each term on our school website, and on the **Reach More Parents** app.
- **All** trips are **linked to areas of the curriculum** e.g. Science, History, Geography
- There will also be **local trips** eg. Library, Religious buildings, local area walks. These trips are linked to children's learning. *If your child does not attend, their absence will be registered as an unauthorised.*
- Teachers will inform parents of trips and costs in advance which must be paid by the date stated in the letter via ParentPay. ParentPay payment also acts as consent. If payment is not made, we do not have consent to take children on these visits.
- **Parent volunteers** are encouraged and will be selected randomly before the trip. We can only take a **limited number** of adults on each trip. This includes school staff.
- Teachers will inform parents if they have been chosen.
- *All school trips are compulsory for pupils.*

Religion and Worldviews Trips

- Educational visits to places of worship are a fundamental **part of the curriculum**.
- Purpose = embed knowledge and deepen understanding.
- Children **WILL NOT BE ASKED TO PARTICIPATE IN ACTIVITIES SPECIFIC TO ANY RELIGION.**
(E.g praying or worshipping).
- Please speak to Mrs Kennedy-Medford (Assistant Headteacher) or to the Religion & Worldviews Lead (**Ms. Williams**) if you have any queries regarding a RWV trip.

How do we communicate with you?

1. Meeting with your child's teacher

- Termly parents meeting or reports are planned into the academic year. Please ensure you book an appointment through our [Reach More Parents](#) (RMP by Weduc) app.
- If you need to discuss something, please come and speak to us when you collect your child at the end of the day.
- If you are going to need a longer amount of time, then please arrange an appointment via the school office or with the teacher at collection time.
- Appointments with a class teacher in the morning need to be before 8:30am (*in agreement with the teacher*) or after the children have been dismissed at 3:20pm.

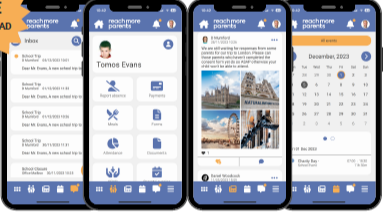

We post all our key school information in one school app for parents/carers, so no one misses out, including:

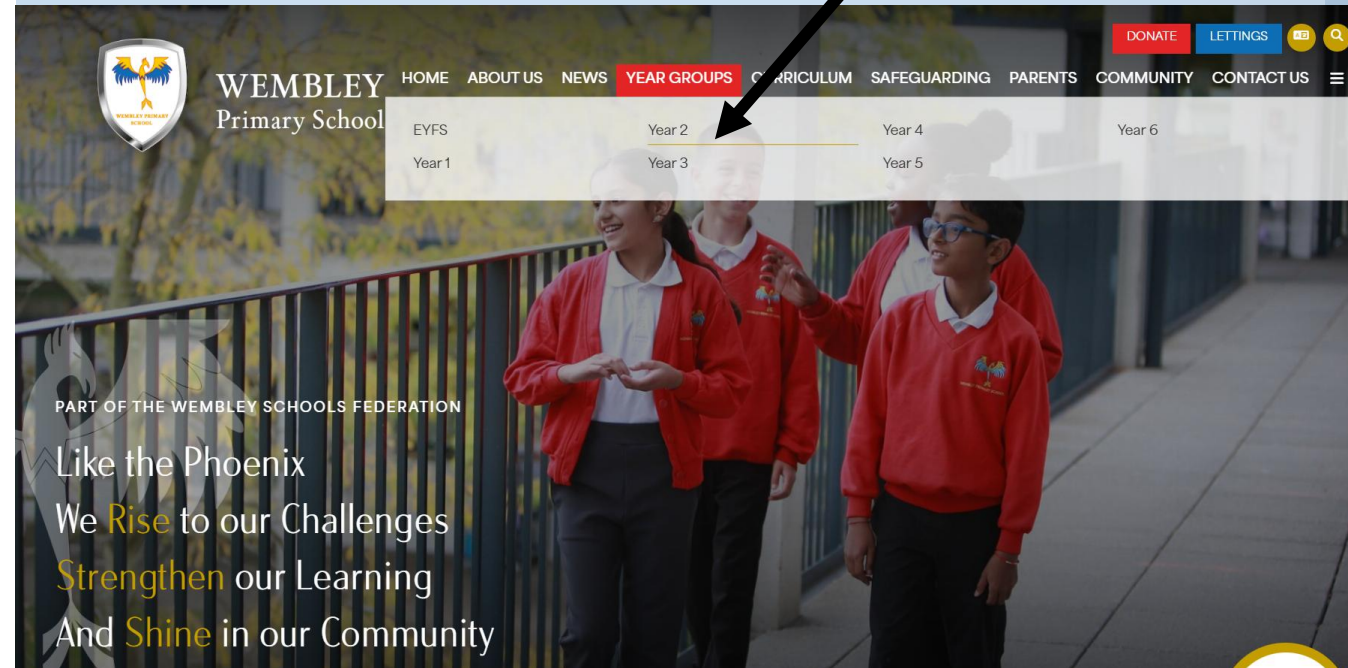
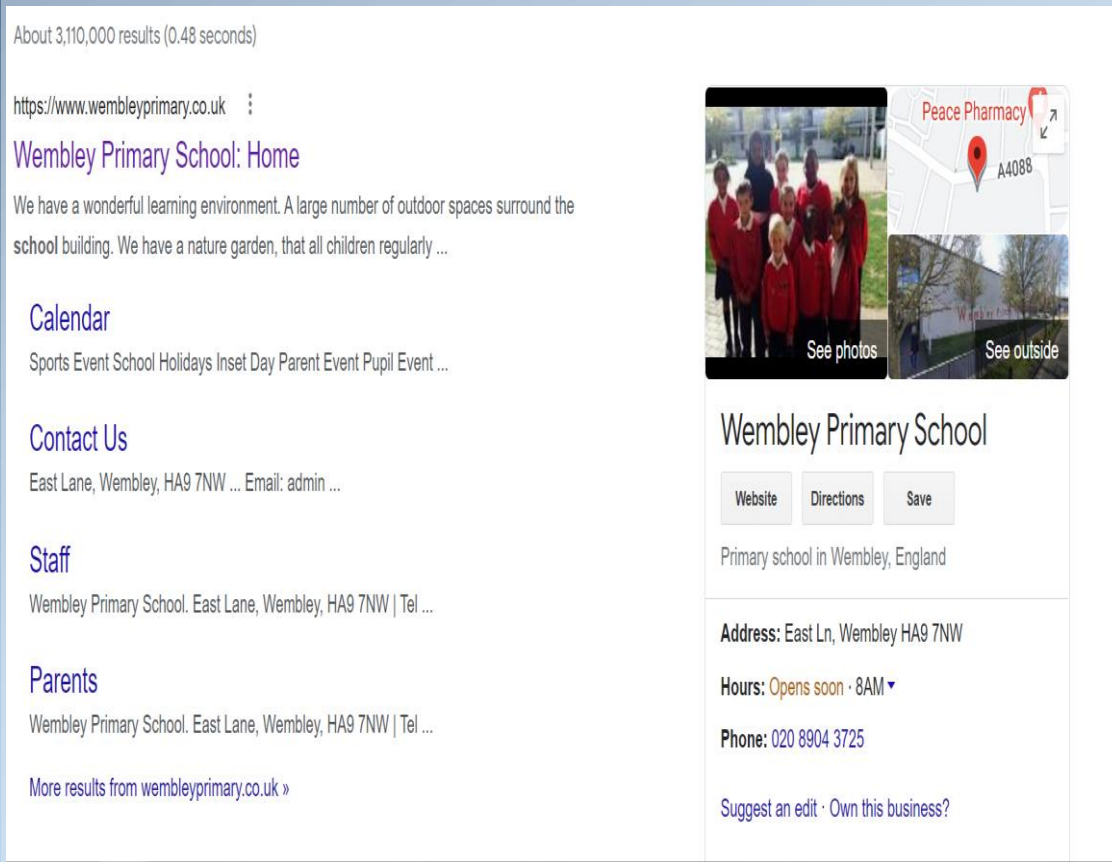
