- A **healthy** and **nut-free** snack eg. Fruit, vegetable

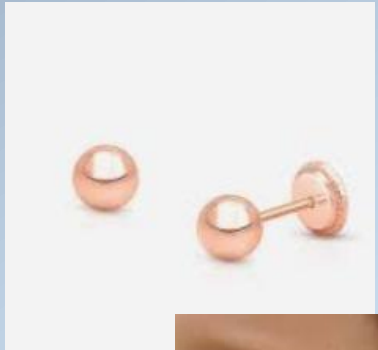


Jewellery

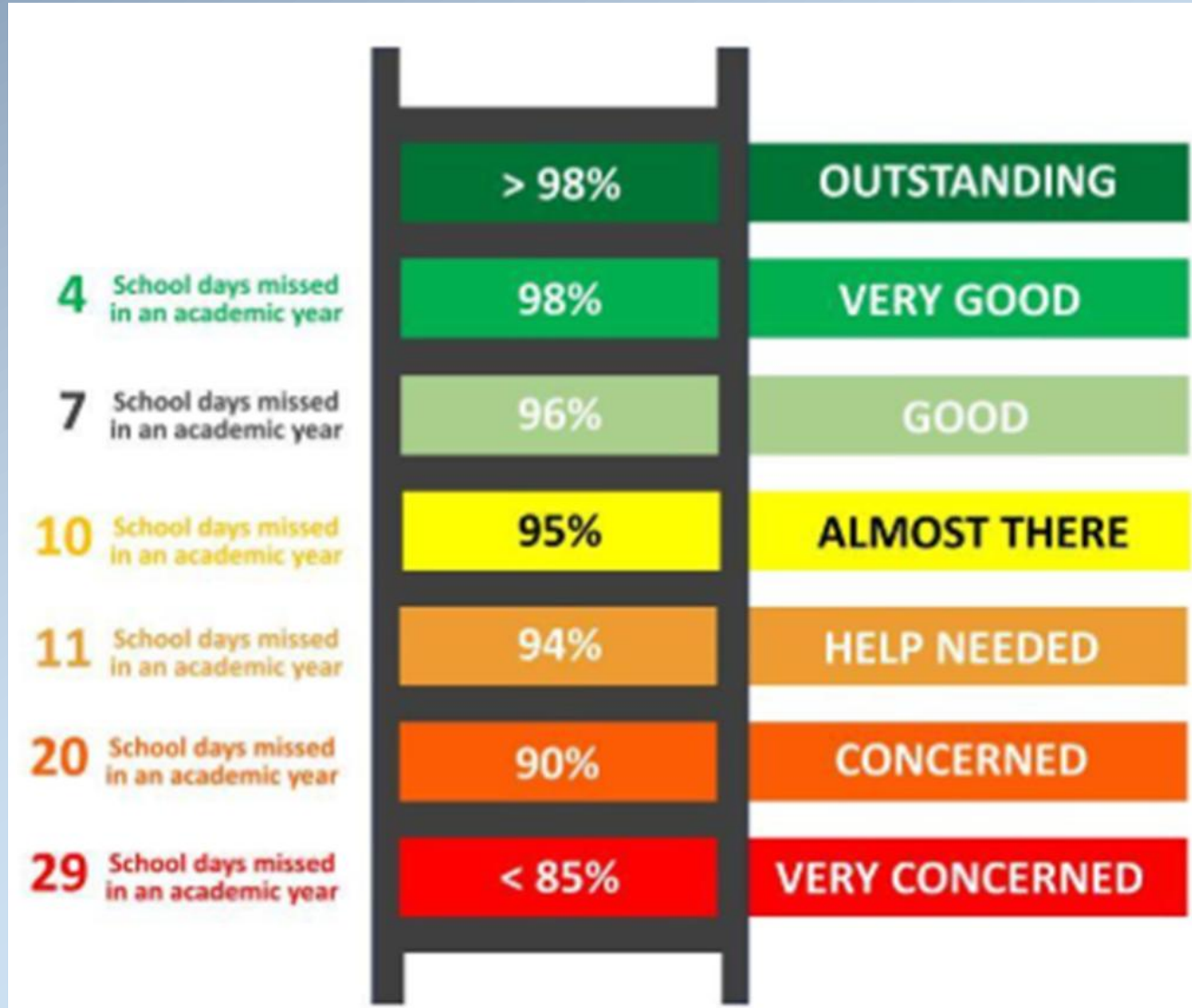

Attendance and Punctuality



- It is vital that your child comes to school **every day** and on time
- We **do not authorise** any term-time holidays. Unauthorised holidays **may result in a fine** by the Educational Welfare Officer
- Soft start begins at **8:35**
- Registers close at **8.50**
(Teaching starts promptly and your child will be marked late if they arrive after this time.)
- Please ensure you are collecting your children on time from the classroom at **3:30pm**.

School Lunch and Snacks

- **This year, all primary aged children** are entitled to a free school meal. You do not need to pay!
- Your child does not have to have a school dinner every day. Check the school website to see the menus and you can choose which meals your child would like to eat.
- Year 3 children must bring in a **healthy and nut-free** snack. eg. Fruit, vegetable (cakes, sweets or biscuits are **not** allowed).
- If you are in receipt of any benefits, please apply for **Free School Meals**. You can enquire about this at the main Reception.

Reading

- Children in Year 3 will be expected to read for at least **20 minutes** every day.
- Most books will be a **colour-banded book** which is matched to their reading assessments.
- Children's book bands are determined upon teacher and reading assessments.
- If children are reading below age related expectations, they may be reading a phonetically decodable book. Assigned books will be linked to the phonic sound children are learning
- Reading records **must** be signed by an adult and brought in **daily**. Lost/damaged books will be charged **£5 per book**.

Spellings

- Test and new spellings on **Fridays**

Spelling lists will be based on statutory spelling patterns and common exception words; more information can be found on our school website.

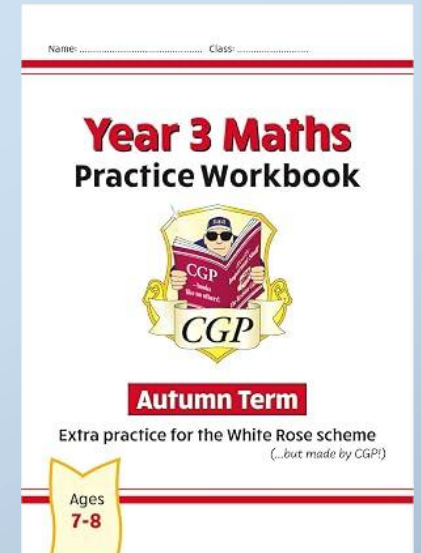
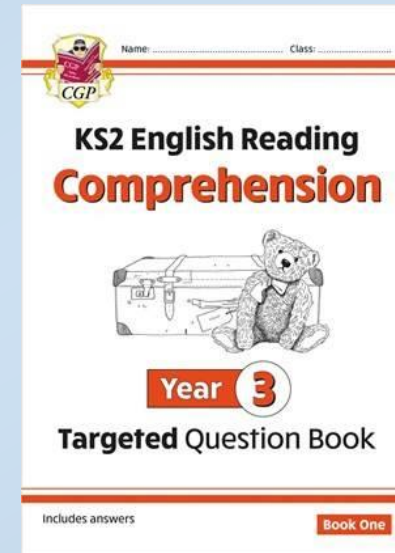
Make sure children learn the spellings and the spelling rules. They should practise their spellings (and handwriting) by writing the words in sentences

KIRFs are the number facts that children should be able to recall **quickly and accurately**, without having to work them out. These include facts such as number bonds, times tables and simple fraction facts.

How can you help at home?

Practising KIRFs for just **5 minutes a day** can make a huge difference. Little and often is much more effective than longer practice sessions.

This half term, your child needs to ...

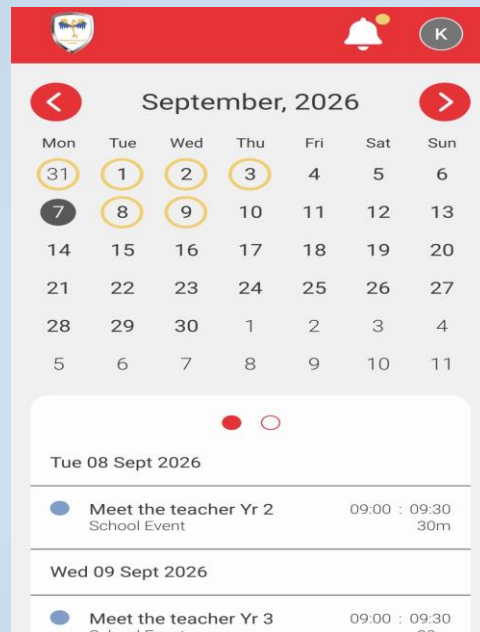
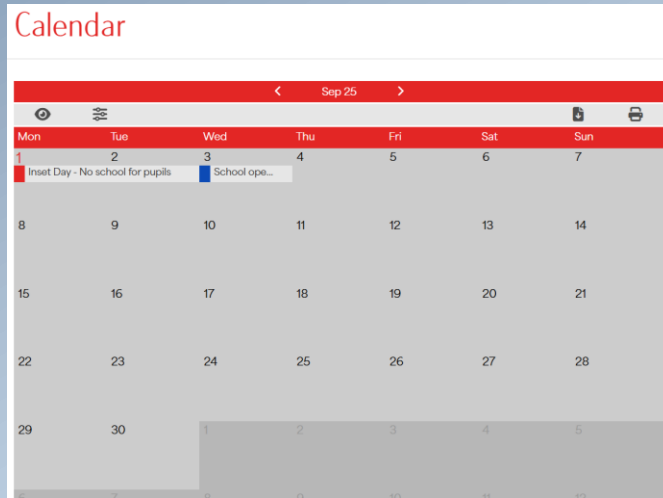
- Children will need to log into TTRS twice a week to learn their times tables.

After School Clubs

- A list of After School clubs will be available in the next 2 weeks. Children will only be able to **attend one session per week**.
- The booking will go live on **Parent Pay at 5pm on the release day**. If a space is available, children will be given their 1st choice club then removed from any additional preferences.
- **Waiting lists** will be created if a club is over-subscribed. Additional spaces may be offered if available. You will be contacted from the school office, if a place becomes available.
- **Invited (booster) clubs** – You will receive a letter from a class teacher prior to clubs becoming available. This is a paid club and will run for 8 weeks and will be based on teacher assessments to address specific gaps in learning. *(These clubs will be offered at a discounted price of £15 instead of £170).*

Trips



- Our [parent calendar](#) of key dates is updated each term on our school website, and on the [Reach More Parents](#) app.
- **All** trips are **linked to areas of the curriculum** e.g. Science, History, Geography
- There will also be **local trips** eg. Library, Religious buildings, local area walks. These trips are linked to children's learning. *If your child does not attend, their absence will be registered as unauthorised.*
- Teachers will inform parents of trips and costs in advance which must be paid by the date stated in the letter via ParentPay. ParentPay payment also acts as consent. If payment is not made, we do not have consent to take children on these visits.
- **Parent volunteers** are encouraged and will be selected randomly before the trip. We can only take a **limited number** of adults on each trip. This includes school staff.
- Teachers will inform parents if they have been chosen.
- *All school trips are compulsory for pupils.*

Religion and Worldviews Trips

- Educational visits to places of worship are a fundamental **part of the curriculum**.
- Purpose = embed knowledge and deepen understanding.
- Children **WILL NOT BE ASKED TO PARTAKE IN ACTIVITIES SPECIFIC TO ANY RELIGION. (E.g praying or worshipping).**
- Please speak to Mrs Kennedy-Medford (Assistant Headteacher) or to the Religion & Worldviews Lead (**Ms. Williams**) if you have any queries regarding a RWV trip.

How do we communicate with you?

1. Meeting with your child's teacher

- Updating you on your children's progress – we will do this through our termly parents meeting or reports.
- If you need to discuss something, please come and speak to us when you collect your child at the end of the day.
- If you are going to need a longer amount of time, then please arrange an appointment via the school office or with the teacher at collection time.
- Appointments with a class teacher in the morning need to be before 8:30am (*in agreement with the teacher*) or after the children have been dismissed at 3:30pm.

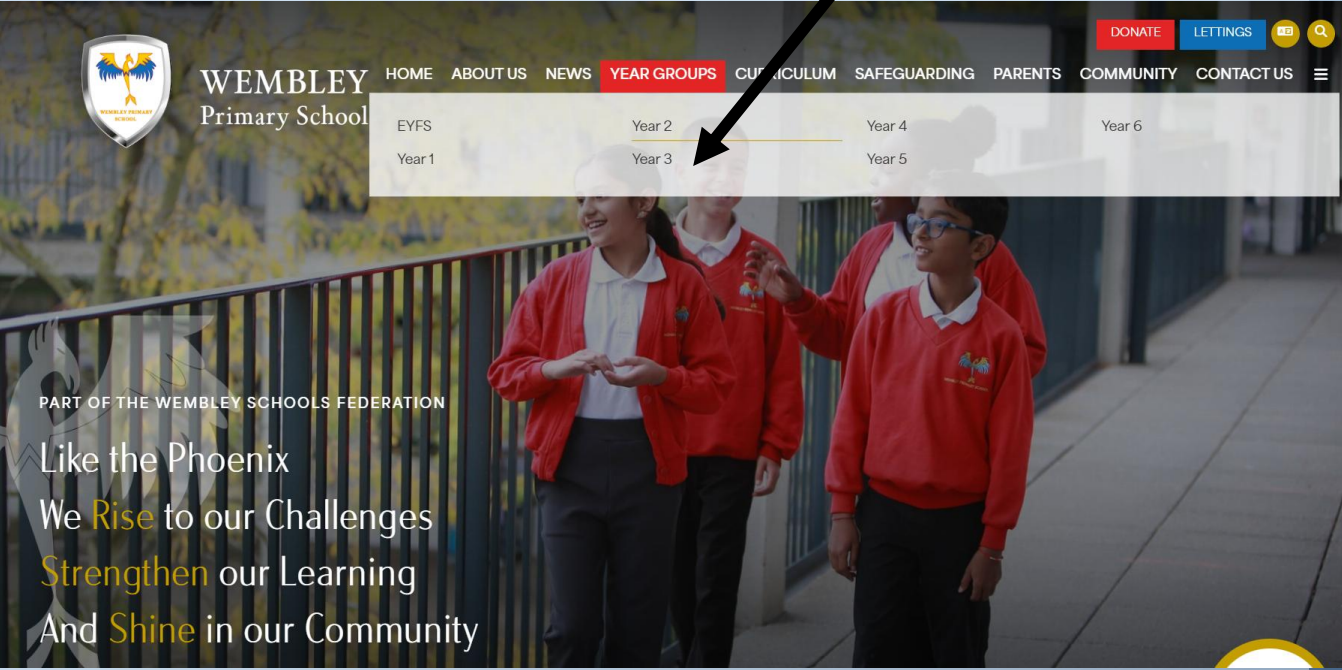
