Welcome back Year 1!

We hope you have had a pleasant holiday and are ready for the new term. There is a lot to do this half term, so we hope this letter will enable you to support your child with their learning at home.

English

This half term children will be looking at **stories with a familiar setting, and non fiction books.**

Children will be:

- Using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in their writing.
- Writing short narratives.
- Identifying and describing characters and settings.
- Role-playing stories.
- Re-telling stories.

How can you help your child at home?

Encourage them to practice their handwriting. Learn the Year 1 common exception/high frequency words which will be sent home.

Science

Our topic this half term is Animals including humans. We will be describing and comparing the structure of a variety of amphibians, birds, reptiles, mammals and fish. We will also be observing, describing, and recording the changes in weather over the season of autumn.

Computing

Our topic this half term is Digital Painting. The children will develop their understanding of a range of tools used. They will use these to create their own digital paintings using a range of artists work. Children will finally discuss their preferences when painting with and without digital devices.

Art

Our focus this term will be skylines and landscapes. The children will be learning to use different pencil strokes and colours to create pictures of various skylines and landscapes.

History

Our topic this half term will be on Amy Johnson the pilot. Children will be using different skills to answer questions. They will focus on why she was famous, known as the Queen of the Air and where she flew to. How people reacted to her famous flight and what happened to her providing reasoning for their answers.

Music

Music will be delivered by a Brent schools music teacher who will be focusing on rhythm skills and patterns and singing using accurate pitching.

Religion and World Views

Our topic this term will focus on special people.

Children will learn how the nativity story shows Jesus as special and the Christian beliefs. They will also read other religions birth stories and consider the values.

Maths

Our focus this term will be addition, subtraction and geometry.

Place Value

Children will be

- Counting, reading and writing numbers to 100 in numerals.
- Counting in multiples of twos, fives and tens from 0.
- Identify one more and one less of a given number.
- Count to and across 100, forwards and backwards.

Addition and Subtraction

Children will be

- Representing and using number bonds to 20.
- Represent and use subtraction facts within 20.




In PSHE, we will be learning about things that go into our bodies which can be either helpful or harmful .





