




Parent Consultations

- We expect all parents to add photos and videos of their child on Tapestry to build up a better profile of your child.

Before September...

When you child starts Reception there are a number of skills that they should ideally have mastered:

Self-care:

- Go to the toilet by self
- Be able to wash own hands
- Put on own shoes and socks
- Put on coat and do zip
- Eat using knife and fork

Speaking & Literacy:

- Show an interest in books
- Recognise and begin to write own name
- Talk about themselves, needs & feelings
- Ask and answer simple questions

Numeracy:

- Count to 10
- Recognise numbers to 10
- Write some numbers to 10
- Name simple shapes

Listening and understanding:

- Be able to tidy up
- Follow instructions
- Share and take turns
- Talk to other children

Activities you can do over the summer...

At the open day, you will have received an activity pack with:

Getting ready for school poster

This outlines some core skills your child can start to do to get school ready.

- A die

Use this with your child to help them become familiar with numbers to 6.

A number line

You can use this with your child to see what numbers come before and after numbers to 10 or 20

- Letter formation

Use this to help your child to start recognising and forming letters.

Number formation

Use this to help your child to start recognising and forming numbers.

Phase 2 Sound Mat

Children will begin phonics as soon as they start in Reception. Use this alongside the phase 2 pronunciation video to help your child become familiar with sounds.

What next...

You should have received your admissions pack. Please read it carefully!

Complete the Admissions form and return it to the school office asap with 2 proofs of your address no older than 2 months and your child's passport and birth certificate.

Your child will not be able to start school if it hasn't been completed.
