- Jewish people wear clothes to symbolise their beliefs and respect to God.
- Sikhs believe everyone is equal to God and the 5Ks show their beliefs and values.
- Muslims believe in and follow the 5 Pillars of Islam and wear clothes to show everyone is equal.


